## BEFORE USE

Please ensure you familiarise yourself with the Terms and Conditions of the KCH *Party Equipment Hire Agreement*.

## EQUIPMENT LIST

### 1. Projector

- Toolpro (hardcase) housing Benq projector
- Remote control
- Power cord
- HDMI cord
- PC cord
- Bluetooth/wireless dongle



### 2. Blow up screen

- Smart Digital Australia blow up cinema screen
- 8 x White tie down straps
- 4 x yellow pegs
- Stored inside large black Smart Digital bag



### 3. Trolley

- Stanley 2-in-1 folding hand trolley



### 4. Quickpump

- Coleman quickpump
- 2 x attachments



### 5. Speakers

- 2 x Vonyx speakers
- Power cord
- Speaker connection cord
- Auxiliary cord
- Remote control
- Stored inside Smart Digital bag on wheels



### 6. DVD/Blu-ray player

- Panasonic DVD/Blu-ray player
- Power cord
- HDMI cord
- Remote control
- Stored inside a small soft Smart Digital bag

## SET-UP INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Time required to setup/pump the screen is approximately 30 minutes.

### Projector

- Connect the power cord to the projector and plug into the power point
- Press the power button either on the projector or the remote

Options to screen via:

- a. DVD player (provided – DVDs not supplied)
- b. Bluetooth/Wireless dongle (provided – needs another device and/or WiFi)
- c. Computer/laptop
- d. Chrome Cast (not provided – casting of another device eg phone)

### Blow up screen

- Once you got the screen out of its bag look for the 'Smart Digital' sign, in the bottom left corner
- Pump hole is in the back, to the right of the 'Smart Digital Australia' sign

Note: You will require approximately 4.5m width, 3m height and 2.5m depth for the screen setup. Please ensure adequate clearance is given from trees, fans, or anything else that could contact, fall onto and/or damage the screen.

### Quickpump

- Connect to power
- Attach the necessary attachment
- Turn on and pump the screen up

### Speaker

- Connect the power cord to the main speaker
- Connect the 2 speakers
- Connect to projector using the auxiliary cord
  - Single connections into the projector – back green hole (out)

- Double connections into the main speaker (red to red – white to white)
- Turn the power on
- Adjust the sounds via the remote or back of the main speaker

Note: Cables can pose a trip hazard. Ensure cables are secured or otherwise kept out of walkways.

### DVD/Blu-ray player

- Connect power cord to DVD player and into the power point
- Connect the DVD player and the projector via HDMI cord
- Turn the power on, both devices
- Select HDMI button on the projector remote
- Select open/close button on the DVD player > insert the Disc > Select open/close button
- Follow instructions on the screen to play

Note: Please observe restrictions relating to public screening of films. Unless a film is being screened at a private residence, a licence will be required. For more information and tips, refer to: <https://www.smartdigital.com.au/9-ways-cut-movie-licencing-costs/>

### Wireless dongle

- Turn the projector on
- Plug the wireless dongle in the USB port in the back of the projector
- Select 'Wireless projection' shown on the screen
- Select the type you will be using to play/cast from eg android
- Connect to WiFi
- Cast off your device
